Surveyed the S.S. "TERUTAMA MARU" 5771 tons gross of Hakodate, on the 15th March 1956 and subsequently, whilst she lay in drydock and afloat at Yokohama on account of General Examination for postponement of Special Survey, Damage, Alterations, and S.R. List,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be continued as now classed with fresh record of Survey 4/56, subject to the Special Survey being completed by 10/56, forty five fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity, Deep Tanks not being used for Water Ballast or fuel oil until repaired, to well Plate H11 (S3) being examined and dealt with as found necessary at the Special Survey but without condition regarding the examination of No.2 Hold and Deck plating in way of Poop, indented shell plating in way of Nos.2,3 & 4 Hds (S3) and shell plating (PSF)

being fit to carry her usual cargoes.
