MS due 4.51 now held.

BS due 10.51 now held and screwshaft examined.

Wear and tear repairs

HP cylinder found cracked and temporarily repaired by fitting a patch. The Surveyor recommends this be specially examined by 6.52. *It is considered the Machinery Survey record should be withheld meantime.*

Main and auxiliary condensers retubed.

An additional 30 KW steam driven generator set fitted and switchboard and cables altered to suit.

Alterations

Donkey boiler removed from ship.

Main boilers converted to burn oil fuel, in accordance with approved plans and Rule requirements.
