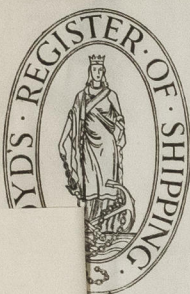

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of The Owners and on behalf of the underwriters attend aboard the S.S. "SLITAN" 2932 tons gross of Fredrikstad as she lay afloat and in Georges Dimitroff Dry Dock at Varna on 11th May, and subsequently to examine the vessel subsequent to Grounding off Palembang 6th March 1961.

It was stated that while manouvering in River in Palembang control over the vessel was lost in the strong current and the vessel touched a pier and several small sailing vessels before grounding at 17.41 hrs. the vessel was unable to free herself and refloating was assisted by tugs.

The vessel was examined afloat and in Dry Dock, and no damage attributable to this grounding was discovered.

The vessel docked pm. 13th May, 1961 and was placed in dock with 3 other vessels and was expected to be in dock for 5 days, while necessary repairs were completed on the other vessels.

The examination for grounding was however completed on 14th May, 1961.
