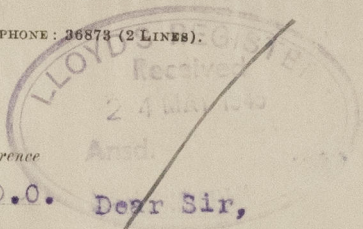

In reply to the query contained in your letter of the 18th instant, we have to state that the reason for the fitting of steering chains 5/8" in diameter in "VIC 81" was due to the delay in receiving the 9/16" chains on order for this vessel and as 5/8" chains intended for another vessel had been delivered in good time, these chains were fitted in "VIC 81" to facilitate the vessel being put into service.
