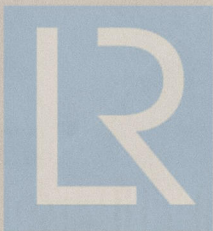
He states that the Special Reasons List indicated that First Entry Reports were required for the machinery, boilers and electrical equipment, and as some of the machinery was opened up, he was able to prepare a machinery First Entry Report. He concluded that the hull First Entry Report had already been prepared, as the SRL stated the Classification Special Survey had been partly held.

Although he advanced the Special Survey, he regrets that he took no particulars for the preparation of a First Entry Report.
