
I have received a request from prospective buyers of the above vessel regarding the possibility of our carrying out a survey as per copy of letter attached.

With regard to "Report defect 9/61", I understand that nothing has been done about the defective boiler furnaces and it is unlikely that the Owners would be prepared to do anything about them under the present circumstances.
