

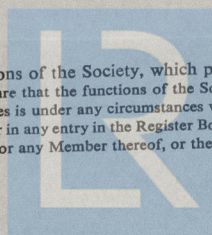
This is to certify that the hull of the m.s.
