Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in Newcastle-upon-Tyne 11. 1945.

Alterations to structure at frames 21-23 and 46-48. Now fitted $\frac{1}{2}$ " butt strap on main deck, from main deck to chine Pand S. From chine to keel P&S. $4" \times 4" \times \frac{3}{8}$ angle riveted and the $\frac{1}{2}$ " gap between plate butts welded flush. ✓

The permanent openings in E R casing Pand S now permanently plated. ✓

Sky light flaps on forecasse head skylight now fitted with water tight joint, screws and wing nuts. Two 8" dia glasses fitted with dead lights. ✓

Stanchions and two tier rails now fitted in place of wires at ship's sides. Stanchions $2" \times 3\frac{1}{2}" \times \frac{1}{2}"$ bar welded to deck by two brackets, spaced 6ft. rails 1" dia. } only 2 rails

Please note

The modification to the door of crews companionway forward and the machinery casing doors (steel) to be made operable from both sides and the door sills to be 24" high. } Not yet done

The above item has not been dealt with at this time.

The Owners Supt stated he expects to be able to complete the modification to the above doors and sills before the end of August 1953.
