With reference to the entry in the Register Book Supplement, the Newcastle Surveyors reported in May last that the ship had been examined in drydock and the Donkey Boiler Survey held prior to proceeding to Italy for Special Survey etc. It is noted from the Shipping Papers that she subsequently arrived at Genoa, and I shall be glad to learn how the case now stands.

With regard to the entry in the Special Reasons List No. 182 (under "Laganfield"), as the Special Survey was commenced in December 1958 and advanced in October 1959 all items are now required to be dealt with.

There are no recorded special conditions of class, but attention is drawn to the entry in the Special Reasons List Appendix.

As a result of the above mentioned Newcastle report, the vessel has been assigned records of drydocking date 5.61 and D.B.S. 5.61
