

This is to Certify that this Ship has been built under the Special Survey of the Surveyors to this Society, and was reported to be, on the 1st September, 1953 in a fit and efficient condition as is prescribed by the Society's Rules for the safe carriage of dry and perishable or other approved Cargoes, and has been CLASSED and entered in the REGISTER BOOK of this Society, with the Character  100A1 Carrying Petroleum in Bulk. Fitted for oil fuel 9.53 flash point above 150°F. subject to Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules.

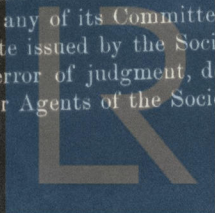
