Dear Sir,

I have been in touch several times recently with the Owners of the "CROSBY DALE" but have not been able to get a decision from them about the future Survey arrangements for the ship. The Managing Director has been ill for some time, and has just had a major operation. His brother does not feel he can make any definite decision without the agreement of the Managing Owner.

The vessel is at present laid up, and I have assurance that they will not attempt to put the vessel into commission until the outstanding Surveys have been held. I expect to have a letter in confirmation of this in the next day or two.

Part of the uncertainty regarding the vessel is due to the fact that they may change her engines. They find that she is not suitable for the Charters which they expected to get.
