This barge was classed "A- Barge to be towed for service on the Great Lakes New York State Barge Canal and between Eastport, Maine and North Virginia carrying petroleum in bulk".

The ship was laid up for some time and subsequently disclassed.

The new Owners require Reclassification and the ship has been under survey for drilling and reclassification at New Orleans.

The New Orleans Surveyors report (11,62 and 5,64) ship examined afloat and in drydock, also for Reclassification and Special Survey including drillings.
