This ship was submitted to the Committee on the 20th March, 1956, when the following class was assigned:-



\*100A1 "For coasting service

above 150°F".

The Owners have now written to say that during the next few months it is proposed to make one or two voyages each month between Heysham and Workington.

They would like to know if the proposed run to Workington will jeopardise the ship's class, or if the Certificate of Class can be amended. This was submitted to the Plans Dept. who (14.5.56) state that the ship is suitable for the proposed service.
