

Pontoon Barge "JAMES ROCKBREAKER VII" - Paris letter
17.1.48.

It is submitted that, in order to assist the Owners, the Special Survey might be commenced by an examination of the vessel afloat so as to advise the Owners as far as possible regarding necessary repairs.

It is further submitted Mr. Taxil be advised as above, and informed that it is concluded from his letter that the Owners will arrange with the local shipyard or some other firm to attend on board the vessel to carry out the necessary opening up and to afford the Surveyors access, but he should confirm this, also that in the meantime, the Southampton Surveyors are being advised and instructed to attend when these arrangements are made.

The Southampton Surveyors should also be advised.
