Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the pontoon barge "JAMES ROCKBREAKER VII" has proceeded in tow to your port where the rock breaking machinery will be installed and the special survey completed.

To complete the survey on the hull the following remains to be done:-

The sheer legs for working rock breaking gear at after end also guide winch, cutter winch and manoeuvring winch to be installed; two Trotman anchors each 10 cwts., 4 Trotman anchors each 7 cwts. and 7 wire ropes each 90 fathoms  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " circumference to be supplied, and the two air pipes to after peak tank supplied at Hull will be fitted in position at your port when the rock breaking machinery is installed.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work, to forward a report on form No. 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
