With reference to letter of the 27th July last
respecting the steam trawler "LAURENCE", I shall be glad to learn
in this case how stands as regards the equipment and Boiler Survey.

In this connection I think it well to inform you that
July last a Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agents at Laurence
reported a spare bow anchor and 60 fathoms of chain cable,
and were lent by the Port Department, placed on board this vessel.
The weight of the anchor and the size of the chain cable were in
cess of Rules requirements, but no Certificates were available.

With reference to my letter of the 2nd May last
respecting surveys at Salvia Bay, I shall be glad to learn the present
situation regarding the outstanding surveys on the under-mentioned vessels,
viz:-
