Messrs. Theodor Zeise, Hamburg and on behalf of Messrs. Howaldtswerke A.G. 1 and the Owners Messrs. Olsen & Ugelstad, Oslo attend at the works of Messrs. Theodor Zeise, Hamburg on the 31st December 1948 and subsequently for the purpose of carrying out an examination and witnessing material tests on a solid 3 bladed bronze propeller stated to be for use on the vessel "KROSSFONN".

On examination found the following.

One bronze three bladed right hand propeller equipped with a "Schnitger Düse"

Diameter	3300 mm
Weight	5062 kg.

This propeller was statically balanced and found satisfactory and as far as could be seen, sound and free from material defects.

A standard test piece taken from the casting indicated the following characteristics: -

Tensile breaking strength	46.7 kg/mm ²
Percentage elongation	26

For identification purposes the propeller has been stamped on the boss thus: -
