In connection with the reclassification of the above vessel, we enclose a part shell expansion showing welded repairs effected during the war period, from which it will be seen that a number of the shell plates have been replaced by several plates of smaller size with welded seams and butts as shown. The Owners' representative will be pleased to learn whether these repairs are considered satisfactory either wholly or partly, or whether it is considered necessary to renew the plates in question with plates of normal size with rivetted butts and seams as originally fitted.
