The class of this vessel was omitted from the reprint of the Register Book in March 1944, as the vessel was reported in enemy-occupied territory.

The vessel was subsequently cut in two and sunk by bombing. The two parts were refloated in June 1948 and taken to Brest.

The NANTES Surveyor reports (8.48) the two portions placed on dry dock and permanent and/or temporary repairs effected to enable same to be towed to Kiel.

It is submitted NO ACTION be taken pending receipt of further information.
