Dear Sir,

This vessel (N°27.781 of the R.B.) was sunk and cut in two by the Germans in the Port of BREST in 1944.

The two parts have just been refloated and placed in dry-dock, they will be temporarily repaired and separately towed to KIEL, where a Shipbuilding yard signed a contract for repairing the vessel in a delay of eight months. She will be sold by the French Government to a Norwegian Cy.

As she was surveyed by Lloyd's in 5-40 I write to the Admiralty about it.
