The Glasgow Surveyors reported in October last that the vessel had been examined on a slipway & the S.S. No 3 red with a view to the reinstatement of her class. She was also lengthened 12' 3"

The case was before the the Glasgow Committee on the 12th Nov? & was deferred of Completion of Machinery Survey & this has now been done.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to have her class reinstated in the R.B. with record of Survey 10.06 & Notations of S.S. No 3 10.06 & len-06 as recommended.
