928 tons gross of Copenhagen, whilst vessel was afloat in Alcantara Dock, Lisbon, on the 6th. December 1954, for the purpose of making an examination of the cargo hatches, coverings and battening arrangements prior to discharge.

The vessel was loaded with a cargo of wheat in bulk and bag from Hamburg to Lisbon.

On examination the hatches were found to be well battened down, tarpaulins, etc. being in good condition and on removal the covers, the cargo, as far as could be ascertained, was found to be in a dry condition, except for approximately 250 Kgs. found to be damp in way of pillar at aft end of No.2 hold caused small fracture in deck overhead.
