With reference to your letter of the 26th ultimo regarding my Machinery First Entry Report No. 25109 on the above vessel, the fabricated engine parts were examined after the shop trials and were found sound and free from defects.

The Scotch Boilers in this vessel are used as steam reservoirs since the rate of generation in the Spanner Boiler is so high. The latter Boiler can also function independently.

A plan showing the relative positions and connections between the Scotch and Spanner Boilers is enclosed herewith.
