Dear Sir,

With reference to Greenock Report No. 25109 respecting the motorship "DAVANGER", I shall be glad if you will request the Surveyors to state if the fabricated MS bedplate, frames and scavenge belt were examined on completion of the full power trials of the machinery and found sound and free from defects.

It is also desired to know in this, and in all future cases where an exhaust gas 'boiler' is fitted, whether the 'boiler' is used only in conjunction with the Scotch Boilers or whether it can function independently. In the first case the 'boiler' is considered as an economiser, and in the second case as a boiler.
