Dear Sir,

With reference to the freeboard assignment of the m.v. "BOTHNIA" I have forwarded to-day the form Rpt.C.12(a) from which you will observe that no timber freeboard has yet been assigned.

The Builders have arranged this with the Dutch Authorities, the bulwark plating being desired 7 m/m by the Authorities for vessels carrying timber as deck cargo.

With regard to your letter of the 8th inst. note at foot, I may state that for the small vessels with engines aft and casings extending far aft on a raised deck, no hood or deckhouse is required by the Dutch Authorities.
