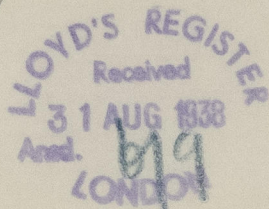



We feel, nevertheless, certain that on consideration of the reasons stated, your Society will agree to the surveys being carried out when we are compelled to stop the vessel for annual survey, as you will understand the loss to us in having to stop the vessel now and again after a short period.
