DJAWATAN PELAJARAN VESSELS

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, in further reference to these ships, and to inform you that at their meeting today, the Committee have rescinded their decision to withdraw the classes of these ships at Owners' request.

In the case of the Motorship "BANGO" however, in which the class was expunged on account of non-compliance with the Rules, the Committee have reverted to their previous decision, and this ship will appear in the Register Book with the notation "Survey Overdue - Class suspended 10,56". In this connection I have to refer to your letter of the 10th ultimo in which you stated that this ship was being directed to Sourabaya where all outstanding surveys would be dealt with, and it is concluded that reports will be received from that port in due course.
