Vessel's Name : M.S. "SAMUDERA" - Plans as Built.

I am in receipt of a letter from Mr. Van der Weel, respecting my letter to your dated 18-10-52.

I hope you will understand that I was not trying to evade the instructions set forth by the Committee. As a matter of fact I thought I was acting in accordance with Circular 1962. The last paragraph of this Circular reads:

If sisterships are building, the plans can be returned to the port after the First Entry has been checked, but must eventually be sent to London with the last series of ships for permanent attention."

So I understood that in the case of sisterships the plans "as built" would be constantly returned by the London Office, until the last sistership is checked, for permanent attention and thus, in the case of sisterships one set of plans could be sufficient.

In the case of the "SAMUDERA" I will forward the required plans to your Office as soon as they have been received from the Rotterdam Office.
