With reference to previous correspondence in case of the above ship we have to say that the Owners now written as follows,

" You are aware that during the last winter the above ship was going to be sent to Karachi for drydocking, the P.I.D.C'S Shipyard at Khulna informed that they would be able to carry out the drydocking in their shipyard. Accordingly the ship was sent there for the drydocking but subsequently they expressed their inability to carry out the drydocking as the cradle of their slipway was not suitable for drydocking this ship. By that time the monsoon set in when it was not possible to send it to Karachi. Arrangements are in hand to send the ship to Karachi for drydocking. "

"It will thus appear that the circumstances for which the drydocking could not be done so long were absolutely beyond our control"

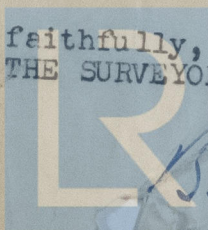
"You are therefore requested to reconsider the suspension of class of this ship as a special case in view of the circumstances stated above"

"You are aware that during the last winter the above ship was going to be sent to Karachi for drydocking, and on 1.1.1901 Shigward at Karachi informed that they would be able to carry out the drydocking in their shipyard. Accordingly the ship was sent there for the drydocking and the owners expressed their intention to carry out the drydocking at the yards of their shipyard. It was not suitable for drydocking this ship at that time the monsoon set in when it was not possible to send it to Karachi. Accordingly the ship is in hand to send the ship to Karachi for drydocking."

"It will thus appear that the circumstances for which the drydocking could not be carried out were absolutely beyond the control of the owners."

"You are therefore requested to reconsider the suspension of claim of this ship as a special case in view of the circumstances stated above."
