I acknowledge your letter of the 24th October and have submitted this case to the Committee here today.


As the Screwshaft Survey in this instance has been outstanding since last March and the Boiler Survey partly held by you last month is still incomplete, the Committee wish you to inform the appropriate Government Authorities that unless a satisfactory proposal is received here by the middle of next month for the outstanding matters to receive early attention, further maintenance of the vessel's class after that time will be prejudiced.

It is appreciated that the vessel has been requisitioned by the Government, but the Karachi Surveyor is being requested to inform the Owners of this decision which has been sent you by cablegram.
