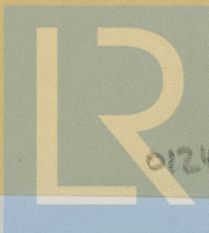
It is of course known that the ship is outside the control of the Owners, but it is considered they will wish to know the possible developments, and I shall be obliged if you will write to them on these lines.
