I, the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. John Manners & Co. Ltd., Merchants of Hong Kong and with the consent of the Owners' Agents, Messrs. Butterfield & Swire (Hong Kong) Ltd., attend onboard the S.S. "TSINAN", 2994 tons gross of London on the 31st August, 1951 and subsequently whilst the vessel was slipped by Messrs. Taikoo Dockyard & Engineering Co. and later whilst she lay afloat, for the purpose of examining the vessel slipped, carrying out a Boiler Survey and further to examine the propeller and screwshaft prior to sale.

Bottom, shell, side plating, stern frame cleaned, examined, found in good order and re-coated.

Port & Starboard Main Boilers opened, cleaned and examined internally & externally in their entirety including shocks & ties, manholes & fastenings and all mountings. General condition found satisfactory and the following repairs only were recommended, these having been satisfactorily effected at this time.

Port Boiler 4 combustion chamber - shell stays found broken and renewed.

Starboard Boiler 4 combustion chamber - shell stays found broken and renewed.
