I have to acquaint you that your Reports of Survey, numbered below, have been submitted to the Committee, and your recommendations confirmed except as stated.

27561, 84, 88, 93. As recommended.

R.M.C 27609, 11, 13. As recommended.

27564. "BULOLO". As recommended.

According to the records in this office, this ship is equipped with four electric generators, and any one of these is capable of supplying power for essential services at sea. It seems, therefore, that there are still two generators in reserve, but as the ship was built in 1938, I shall be glad to receive your confirmation that the generators which were fitted originally, are still on board.

In future similar cases, I shall be glad if you will state whether there is a reserve generator of sufficient capacity on board.

27587. "ST. ARISTELL". As recommended. The Rpt. 8 does not appear to have been received in this office, and I shall be glad if you will forward a copy of the document by return.

27603. (R.M.C) "CHANGTE". As recommended. With reference to your letter of the 22nd ultimo, I shall be glad to learn what early arrangements are proposed by the Owners for completion of the Periodical Survey of the Refrigerating Installation.
