rudder main piece at head and heel are  $6\frac{3}{4}$ " and 5" respect-  
ively, riveting inbar keel is 5" spacing, and in regard to  
the weight and tests of the chain cables, I have to state  
that the Certificate was not produced, the cables have been  
in the builders yard for some three years, and the marks  
were very hard to discern.
