ing letter of the 29th ultimo, respecting the S.S. "ST
ARISTEEL", I have to inform you that the diameter of the
rudder main piece at head and heel are $6\frac{3}{4}$ " and 5" respec-
tively, riveting in bar keel is 5" spacing, and in regard to
the weight and tests of the chain cables, I have to state
that the Certificate was not produced, the cables have been
in the builders yard for some three years, and the marks
were very hard to discern.
