Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that your letter of the 7th ultimo respecting the steamer "RAHUMANI" was read to the Committee at their meeting today.

They are sorry to learn that there was a hint of misunderstanding between your goodselves and the Society's local Surveyor, which apparently led to the vessel leaving without opportunity being afforded for the new oil fuel installation to be passed by him as satisfactory in performance, and although it is now too late for the Society's decision to expunge the class to be rescinded as it has already been carried into effect, the Committee will be pleased to offer immediate classification provided, upon examination by one of the Society's Surveyors, the oil burning installation is found or placed in an entirely satisfactory condition.

I am giving instructions to the local Surveyor to cable this Office immediately this has been done to his satisfaction, and to issue a certificate recommending reinstatement of class under these circumstances against payment of his account.
