Dear Sir,

Please find attached hereto Reports No. 2439 & 2439a in connection with the Classification and S.S. Surveys on the Steam Lighter "RAHUMANI" (Ex "VIC 31").

I beg to inform you that the forwarding of these reports was held up as the Owner informed me that he was having some difficulties with the Registrar General in the United Kingdom over the change of name and port of Registry also some difficulty over the insurance of the vessel had arisen. He stated that the vessel would not be put into service until these matters were settled.

It would appear that these problems have now been settled and the vessel went into service last week.

The name "RAHUMANI" has been reserved by the Registrar General and when certain formalities have been complied with the name will be granted to this vessel.

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In the meantime the vessel is sailing under the old name of "VIC 31" and I have endorsed the interim certificates which were made out in the name "RAHUMANI" accordingly.
