Having, in accordance with your instructions, examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the name of Vessel) "DAUNTLESS STAR"

the (Date of examination) 11th February, 1952.

I have to report that I found FOREMAST (wood) and lutchett (steel) in good condition. Shrouds p. & s. in good condition. Serving and ratlines in good order. Eyeplates renewed and fitted to forward gallows p. & s. Mast stay, foretopmast stay in good order. P. & s. preventer stays renewed with new eyeplates. All rigging screws and shackles renewed foremast stays.

MAINMAST (wood) in good condition. Mast wedges in good condition. Mast coat renewed. Main stay, topmast stay, preventer stays p. & s. renewed. Rigging screws and shackles renewed. Shrouds in good order. Rigging screws renewed. All eyeplates in good order. Boat boom in good condition. Fittings overhauled. Funnel stays fitted.
