The Committee have today had before them the above mentioned cases together with your memorandum of the 4th instant.

In view of the overdue surveys as set forth in my letter of the 6th December 1955, and of the fact that Screwshaft Surveys are now due in the cases of the "QASEEMUL BAHR" and "SAFINATUL HASSAN", the Committee do not feel they should permit the classes of these ships to remain undisturbed in the Register Book; and they have therefore instructed me to bring the cases again before them at the end of August and if no acceptable proposal is forthcoming from the Owners by that date it is quite likely that the class will be expunged in each instance on account of non-compliance with the Regulations.

Should, however, the Owners decide, on reflection, to request withdrawal of class, it is quite possible that the Committee will be prepared to assign a record of 'Class withdrawn at Owners' request'.

I shall, therefore, be obliged if you will again communicate with the appropriate Government Department and inform them of the position as set out above.
