Dredgers "AMINUL BAHR" and "SAFINATUL HASSAN"
Tank Barge "QUASEEMUL BAHR"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, together with its enclosure, the contents of which have been noted and in reply think I cannot do better than refer you to my letter of the 25th July last, which indicated that the above vessels had, in fact, been classed.

The class assigned to the "AMINUL BAHR" and "SAFINATUL HASSAN" was #A1 Dredger "For River Service in East Pakistan" in association with the descriptive notation "Suction Cutter Dredger" and the "QUASEEMUL BAHR" was classed #100A1 "For River Service in East Pakistan" "Carrying oil in bulk P.P. above 150°F".

You should therefore explain the position to the Owners and it may be that this will present a suitable opportunity to issue the Classification Certificates which were forwarded with the above letter and to persuade the Owners to continue classification.
