When Mr. Hill was in the Office recently he referred to the cases of the "AMINUL BAHR", "QASEEMUL BAHR" and "SAPIBATUL HASSAN" classification of which had been withheld pending examination on arrival in Eastern Pakistan.

Mr. Hill was able to satisfy us that the vessels had in fact arrived and had been accepted by the Owners, and in the circumstances the appropriate classes have now been assigned.

It was understood from Mr. Hill that as the vessels were engaged in River Service load line certificates would not be required so that those you have in the Office for these ships may now be cancelled.

I enclose herewith the classification certificates for these craft which I shall be glad if you will retain until Mr. Hill returns as it is possible he may find them of use in persuading the Owners to continue classification.
