



Mr. Hill, the Senior Surveyor at Calcutta, who is home on leave, states that during his occasional visits to the Chittagong area he has seen these three vessels operating, and that as they are on river work they do not require the Loadline Certificates which were forwarded to the Calcutta Office, and are still retained there.

It was arranged with Mr. Hill that the Load Line Certificates should be destroyed and that every effort should be made to assign class in each case now, as he thought that if shown Classification Certificates the Government Officials there would be more likely to maintain class (See his letter 6.4.55).

In the event of this course being adopted the Certificates should be sent to the Calcutta Office for transmission direct to the Owners.
