I have pleasure in forwarding Supplementary Rpt.
No. 1448. together with blue prints of the new Bulkhead and
Engine seatings as now fitted.

The curved recess and fuel tank attachments provide
a certain amount of horizontal stiffening, the bottom strake
as fitted is of '38. plate for 4'6". measured from keel.

All rivetting is watertight pitch, the work having
been hose & fume tested, (sulphur pots in hold).

I shall be pleased to receive your approval or
otherwise in this case, also kindly forward a minimum of any
additions should this bulkhead not meet the Requirements.

May I ask special consideration of the Committee,
no alterations in this vessels permeability having been made.
