E. I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyor at Auckland reports that new heavy oil engines have been fitted on board the m.s. "PUKEKO", and were constructed by Messrs. Fairbanks Morse Company. The numbers of the engines were 758354 and 756398 and the identification mark PHB.
