Remarks Postponement of the completion of the Special Survey until the end of the present month agreed to by the Committee on the 30th September last.

In September the Amsterdam Surveyors reported that the main engine reverse reduction gear was found damaged and repairs were effected.

A letter has now been received from the Amsterdam Surveyors intimating that the Owners are proposing to renew the reverse reduction gear. This item is due for delivery during November but the Owners anticipate that it will be Christmas before the vessel will be submitted to survey as it will take some weeks for the heavy engine part to be transported to IJmuiden.
