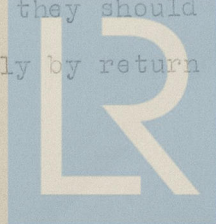

whether in her present condition the vessel is capable of

it is concluded that it is not considered necessary to  
insert any condition against the vessel's class regarding  
the indented and pitted shell plating respectively, and that  
the latter may be ascribed to lack of paint and not to any  
defect in the material, but they should state if this is so.
