
We beg to enclose herewith a copy of a letter received from Messrs. Cochrane & Sons, Ltd. in respect of the fees to be charged for their Yard Nos. 1211, "LE ROYAL", now named "POST BOY".

After the vessel was launched, she was requisitioned by the Admiralty, and as the machinery could not be delivered before the end of 1940, it was decided, with the consent of the Admiralty, to hand over the work of conversion and outfit to Messrs. Doig, Ltd., Grimsby, who had the machinery installation contract.

We shall be glad to know if the suggested fee of 75% of the normal fee meets with your approval.
