This vessel is a repeat of the same Builders' No.585, "BEN HANN", excepting that the Admiralty have stated that the extras embodied in the "BEN HANN" should be omitted in this case. On the 15th August, 1940, the following angles were approved in lieu of the bulb angles shewn on the plan:-

<u>Bulb Angles</u>	<u>Equivalent Angles</u>
5½" x 3" x .30"	6" x 3" x .40"
.35"	6" x 3" x .48"
.40"	6" x 3" x .54"
6" x 3" x .32"	7" x 3" x .42"
.35"	7" x 3" x .44"
.38"	7" x 3" x .46"
.46"	7" x 3" x .54"

and on the 23rd August, 1940, a proposal to use 7" x 3¼" x .30" bulb angles in lieu of 6" x 3" x .32" to .46" bulb angles was also approved.

There is nothing further in the correspondence affecting the First Entry.
