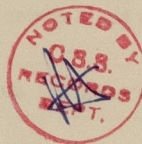
Midship deck house front casing fractured horizontally at sides.

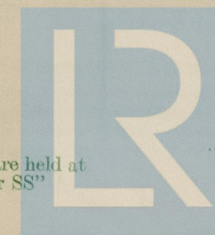
