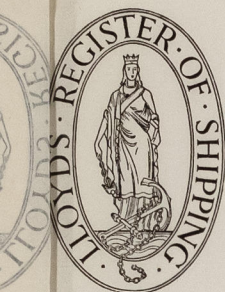

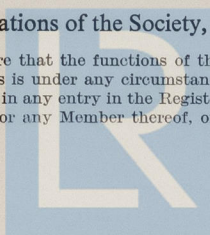
This is to Certify *that I have*

gross tons, of Palermo, on the 28th July 1958 and subsequently
whilst she lay afloat and in dry dock at this Port, for Main
Boiler Survey, Docking, Tail Shaft & Damage Repairs
and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's
Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all
recommendations made by me in connection therewith have
been carried out to my satisfaction, and that I have
Recommended that the record of Tailshaft Survey - Continuous
Liner 7/58 now and Main Boiler Survey 8/58 when the survey
has been completed,
be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel. subject
to four stay tubes of the Stbd. boiler centre nest being
renewed by the end of January 1959 (6 months' limit). To
complete the Main Boiler Survey both boilers to be examined
in working condition and all the safety valves to be adjusted
under steam.
